


# The Garden District

## 2010 Garden Awards Nomination Rules

The 2010 Business & Residential Garden Awards have been updated for this year. Please take note of the following items when considering whether to nominate someone.

- Awards for 2010 are based on curb appeal/ Front yards only. Judges will be viewing your property from the street and their score will be based on how your property appears to the average passerby.
- Awards will be given for: 1ST, 2ND, 3RD Place as well as categories for most improved, great places in small spaces.
- All award recipients must agree to display the garden awards yard sign throughout the growing season.
- All nominated properties must be within the boundaries of The Garden District (13th Aldermanic District.)
- Nomination forms must be postmarked by Friday July 9th. Judging will take place July 10th to July 24th.
- Nominees will be notified after July 24th with additional information. All Nominees grant the Garden District use of images of their garden in publications without compensation.
