2024 ASSESSMENTS

The Assessor's office has posted 2024 property assessments online and sent notices by U.S. mail. City-wide, property values increased \$3.9 billion, and the 11th District increased by \$447.9 million. D11's average assessment is \$188,054. Know that higher assessments don't necessarily correlate to higher property taxes, but if you think your assessment is not accurate, please submit an appeal to the Assessor's office. The deadline to do so is **May 20th**.
