## Ald. Joe Davis Leads Live Congressional City Conference Foreclosure Panel On CSPAN

Milwaukee Common Council member Joe Davis, Sr. (District 2), facilitated a foreclosure crisis panel today at the National League of Cities' (NLC) Congressional Conference in Washington, D.C. Ald. Davis, chair of the Community and Economic Development Policy and Advocacy Committee of the NLC hosted this morning's panel, "Cushioning the Fall: Federal Response to the Subprime Mortgage Crisis." The event, covered live on CSPAN earlier today, began with Davis' opening comments on the foreclosure crisis and his introduction of several members of the lending industry and advocates for housing help.
