Driver's Map Test

In order to get a City of Milwaukee license to drive a public passenger vehicle, you must pass a test of Milwaukee area geography and knowledge of the City's public passenger vehicle ordinance. The test is given before the Defensive Driving Course which is also required. It will have 40 questions and you must get 28 correct to pass. The test **starts two hours before** the scheduled Defensive Driving Course.

You should be familiar with the basic layout of the City, the street numbering system, diagonal streets and the location of important places. Additional information regarding the public passenger vehicle ordinance is available from the **License Division, Room 105, City Hall**
