Resolution authorizing the application, acceptance, and funding of the “Make it in America Challenge”, U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration technical assistance grant to determine feasibility of a Center for Advanced Manufacturing at Century City.

Whereas, this resolution authorizes the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee (RACM) to apply, accept and fund a U. S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration Grant to determine the feasibility of a Center for Advanced Manufacturing at Century City.

Whereas, The U. S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration Grant is part of an overall federal program entitled, “Make it In America” providing funding opportunities for organizations such as RACM; and

Whereas, RACM has determined that the operation of this Grant program will be administered by the RACM. The grant amount is \$100,000 provided by the Grantor with \$20,000 in matching funds provided by the RACM Century City account; and


Whereas, RACM would ensure proper staff would maintain records documenting all expenditures and submit reports as required by the grantor; now, therefore be it
