Resolution approving the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee (RACM) Employee Handbook.

Whereas, RACM is an independent public corporate body created by Wisconsin state statute in 1958 (Wis. Stats § 66.1333(3)) to eliminate blight conditions that inhibit neighborhood reinvestment, to foster and promote business expansion and job creation and to facilitate new business and housing development; and

Whereas, the Authority employs a dynamic team of professionals to carry out the redevelopment efforts of the City, and provide the best quality service to Milwaukee's residents, neighborhoods and businesses; and

Whereas, RACM does not have an official standing Employee Handbook; and

Whereas, the Authority desires to model employment policies and procedures, compensation and benefits, and professional responsibility guidelines to achieve parity, where appropriate, between City Development and Redevelopment employees; and

Whereas, RACM's Employee Handbook will formally communicate these policies, procedures and guidelines to employees; and

Whereas, the proposed RACM Employee Handbook has been distributed to the Authority prior to this meeting for their review; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee, that the attached Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee (RACM) Employee Handbook is approved and effective immediately.
