Resolution relative to application, acceptance, and funding of a State of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Coastal Management Program grant for a redevelopment plan for the Inner Harbor area in the City of Milwaukee.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee Sustainability Plan, ReFresh MKE, adopted by the Common Council on December 17, 2013, identifies the Inner Harbor as a Catalytic Project; and

Whereas, In the Sustainability Plan, the City of Milwaukee has identified the Inner Harbor as a prime target for redevelopment full of economic potential, untapped ecological resilience, and inherent to a working waterfront with a potential to reach the goal of remediating 100 acres of brownfields by 2023; and

Whereas, the Redevelopment Authority is eligible for grant funds from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program (WCMP) to create a Waterway Plan for the Harbor District in Milwaukee that will enable the Redevelopment Authority to develop a plan that will guide redevelopment; and

Whereas, the Redevelopment Authority recognizes that grant eligible activities including facilitating community involvement, conducting research into the existing conditions of the project area, developing a detailed plan, and obtaining technical assistance that builds the local community will be critical steps in the redevelopment of the Inner Harbor; and

Whereas, the Redevelopment Authority will maintain records documenting all expenditures made during the grant period; and

Whereas, the operation of this Grant program from July 2015 to June 2016 would cost up to \$125,000, of which \$18,750 (15%) will be provided by RACM, \$56,250 (45%) will be provided by a third party match, and \$50,000 (40%) will be provided by the Grantor; and


Whereas, the benefits to the City from this Grant program appear to exceed the Authority's share of costs and other obligations to be incurred under this program; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee that application, implementation and acceptance of said Grant from the WCMP by the Assistant Executive Director under the terms specified above, is authorized.
