Core Value 3.00 – Integrity, referencing Guiding Principle 3.05


Rule 4, Section 105.00;

The charges having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:


Failure to conform to and abide by the ordinances in effect in the City of Milwaukee.
