The City of Milwaukee's Office of Environmental Sustainability has an opening for an unpaid intern to create a web-based solar installation site catalogue for Milwaukee Shines – a Solar America Cities project (funded in part by the Department of Energy).

The duration of the internship is from June 1st 2009 – July 31st 2009. Deliverables must be submitted by July 31st, 2009.

Deliverables include:

- Web-based map and web-based catalogue of current solar installations in the Milwaukee metro region with photos and installation specifications. This product will be posted on our website www.milwaukeeeshines.com
- Electronic copies of map and catalogue.

Skills that are required to undertake such a project are graphic design (Photoshop and Illustrator), web design, data collection, marketing, writing and an interest in solar energy. GIS skills are a plus.

This is a great opportunity to boost your portfolio/resume, get into the solar field and work with the Office of Environmental Sustainability.

Work-hours are flexible, though the deadline for completion is fixed. Work-space will be available at City Hall.
