Overnight Parking Restrictions Lifted, December 25th & 26th, January 1st & 2nd

Residents and visitors parking on the streets of the City of Milwaukee do not have to obtain a night parking permit or temporary permission to park on the early morning hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, Christmas Day, and Friday, December 26th, as well as New Year's Day, Thursday, January 1st and Friday, January 2nd. This permission is granted by City of Milwaukee ordinance.

On the dates listed above, alternate side night parking rules also will not be enforced. However, if residents or visitors park on-street overnight on any night s other than the ones listed above between 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. they must obey

Residents and visitors parking on the streets of the City do not have to worry about receiving an overnight parking violation when parking on streets **where nights parking permission or permits are required during winter months. All other posted parking restrictions still apply.**

The City of Milwaukee has also made it easier to obtain night parking permission for visiting family and friends. Residents can obtain night parking permissions online by accessing www.parking.mpw.net. All you need to provide is the license plate number and the address where the vehicle will be parked. Night parking permission can also be obtained by contacting the Parking Information Desk at 286-8300 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., Sunday through Friday.

Parking meter regulations are not in effect on December 25th and January 1st.
