### **Juvenile Auto-Theft Presentation Follow-Up Questions (05/19/2017)**

- What is the demographic breakdown for DCS?
- Breakdown of why specifically an override happened (DCS)?
- What is the ALOS for juveniles after release?
- Questions around recidivism rates for juveniles and adults. (A discussion on why this fell out of the scope of this particular analysis followed.)
- What is the demographic breakdown for DOC?
- What is the risk/demographic profile for individuals in SJOC?
- Are individuals who are appropriate for beds locally not getting them?

### **Adult Auto-Theft Presentation Follow-Up Questions (07/19/2017)**

- What is the demographic breakdown (age, in particular) of the released to future court date.
- Has there been an increase in Auto-related Robberies over time?
- How do OAWOOC charging issuance rates compare relative to a different date range?
- A presentation on the new pre-trial tool for the Executive committee.
- What are the safety and appearance rates for OAWOOC & Robbery (Auto) since switching to the PSA for pretrial decision-making?
- Should there be additional consideration for OAWOOC related cases being placed into category “step 2”?
- Do COMPASS scores correlate with these populations LSI-R scores?

- i.) **Introductions** – Mandy called the meeting to order at 8:36am. Amy Rodriguez will be replacing Patty Beyer-Robinson on this committee beginning in July.
- ii.) **Adult Auto Theft Presentation Date** – July 19, 2017 – Mandy informed the group that at the most recent Executive Committee meeting, the Committee selected the date of July 19<sup>th</sup> from 12:15-1:30pm (2pm, if needed) to have the Data Analysis Committee present the second (adult) portion of the auto theft analysis. No reported calendar conflicts during this meeting.
- iii.) **Next Data Analysis Project – EBDM – Public Policy Forum Partnership** – Following a discussion on Milwaukee's involvement in Phase VI of the Evidence-Based Decision Making Initiative at the June Executive Committee meeting, Rob Henken from the Public Policy Forum volunteered to support the CJC in doing an analysis of the current Universal Screening and Early Interventions programs to help tell Milwaukee's EBDM story to-date. Rob noted that the Public Policy Forum was involved in the original research, which led to the implementation of Universal Screening, and feel there is great value in completing a follow-up analysis to paint the picture of how the program has grown. Following a discussion amongst the committee, Rob agreed to provide the committee with a two-page overview of the proposed purpose and scope of the project.
- iv.) **Dashboard Prototypes – Jail and Criminal Justice System** – Branden DuPont gave an overview of the dashboard prototypes he has been working on. Branden will give a presentation at the next Jail & Huber Committee meeting to show a sample of what these dashboards look like to further examine application.
- v.) **MacArthur Foundation – Safety and Justice Challenge – Data Use Agreement** – must be signed by Friday. Department of Corrections needs to determine who will be signing from the Secretary's office. Patty Beyer-Robinson reported that Angelique Richards is working on this. Corporation Counsel has reviewed and approved the document.
- vi.) **Other Updates/Announcements** – MacArthur Foundation Safety and Justice Challenge Annual Report is also due with the DUA on Friday. The group congratulated and gave well wishes to Patty Beyer-Robinson who will be retiring from the DOC on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
