**Walker Announces Milwaukee County Parks to Host  
2007 Disc Golf World Championships**  
*Attendance Free to Public*

MILWAUKEE – County Executive Scott Walker announced that the 2007 *Professional Disc Golf Association* Amateur & Junior World Championships will take place from July 22 to 28 at three local Milwaukee County Parks: Dretzka – 36 holes, Brown Deer – 18 holes, and Dineen – 18 holes. The Milwaukee County Disc Golf courses have been improved and upgraded for the tournament. Dretzka Park has added an additional 18 holes for a total of 36 for the World Championship Tournament.

“This event offers another exciting sporting event for Milwaukee area residents to enjoy,” said Walker. “Milwaukee County is proud to offer a variety of challenging courses to host this national competition.”

It is anticipated that over 500 players from around the world will compete. International competitors and their families from Germany, Switzerland and Japan are expected to take part in this year’s tournament.

Disc golf is similar to regular golf and is played with a flying disc or a light Frisbee to reach holes from 70 to 300 yards in length. Advanced players can throw their discs more than 150 yards. Fans and spectators are welcome to attend this free, worldwide competition.
