**WALKER CONGRATULATES CHILD SUPPORT WORKER OF YEAR**

MILWAUKEE – County Executive Scott Walker is pleased to announce that Mashunda McGlaston, a paralegal in the Milwaukee County Department of Child Support Enforcement for more than six years, has been named a co-winner of the 2009 Child Support Worker of the Year Award by the Wisconsin Child Support Enforcement Association.

“This award is a credit to Ms. McGlaston’s hard work and determination to help families, especially children, who desperately need these services,” Walker said.

In her nomination, Child Support Enforcement Director Janet Nelson credited McGlaston for helping to develop and implement several community outreach programs such as the Word of Hope Ministries’ Prison Re-entry Project. Every Monday, McGlaston goes to Holy Cathedral Church to provide one-on-one sessions with non-custodial parents to answer questions and help with paperwork to get child support orders adjusted while the parents look for work as part of the re-entry program.

McGlaston also attends events sponsored by the Fatherhood Collaborative of Milwaukee and assists parents with legal issues. She regularly volunteers at the annual Milwaukee Fatherhood Initiative Summit, Prison Outreach sessions around the state and as a loaned executive for Milwaukee County’s Combined Giving Campaign.

Nelson said, “McGlaston’s dedication to her clients and her community service made her an ideal candidate for the award.”
