**WALKER TO ADDRESS COUNTY SENIOR STATESMAN PARTICIPANTS**

MILWAUKEE – County Executive Scott Walker will welcome the Milwaukee County older adults who are participating in the Senior Statesman program at the County Executive’s office today. He will also attend the graduation to be held at the Marcus Center for the Performing Arts at the conclusion of the three-day program.

“I look forward to meeting with the Senior Statesman group every year,” said Walker. “While they learn different aspects about county government, we benefit from their years of experience to keep us informed about issues important to our older adult residents.”

The purpose of the Senior Statesman program is to give older county citizens the opportunity to learn more about the policy-making process regarding senior citizen issues at the county level. Participants acquire an overview of the legislative process, meet with county officials, and attend a meeting of the full County Board. Tours of county facilities are provided.

The program is sponsored by the Milwaukee County Executive’s Office, Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, Milwaukee County Department on Aging, the Wisconsin Geriatric Education Center at Marquette University, and the Coalition of Wisconsin Aging Groups (CWAG).
