FURLOUGH CLOSINGS AT COUNTY FACILITIES

MILWAUKEE – The second of four mandatory furlough days for Milwaukee County will take place Friday, May 28, with several exceptions. See the schedule of department and building closures listed below.

Items of note:

- The Courthouse will be open.
- Courthouse Offices that will be open on the designated furlough days are Courts, District Attorney, Register of Deeds, and the Election Commission (4/2 only).
- The Coggs Center will be closed.
- The Safety Building, Criminal Justice Facility, and Vel Phillips Juvenile Justice Center will be open on all furlough days.
- The Behavioral Health Division - Patient Care units will be open on furlough days, but administrative offices will be closed.
- Parks facilities, golf courses (weather dependent), beaches, indoor pools, community centers, the Domes and Boerner Botanical Gardens will be open on furlough days. The Parks administrative offices will be closed.
- General Mitchell International Airport and Timmerman Field will be open.
- The Milwaukee County Zoo will be open.
- The Medical Examiner's office will be open for all furlough days.
- The Department on Aging and the Aging Care Management Organization (CMO) administrative offices will be closed on the furlough days. Programs and services run by other organizations will be open.
- Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) departments and administrative offices (excluding the Airport) will be closed on all furlough days.
- City Campus will be closed on all furlough days.
