WALKER UNVEILS MILWAUKEE COUNTY STATUS REPORT

MILWAUKEE – At a meeting today of the Kiwanis Club of Milwaukee, County Executive Scott Walker unveiled his status report on Milwaukee County. Today marks the 5th Anniversary of Walker’s first day in office.

The report highlights many of the reforms that have been initiated during Walker’s administration:

- Walker returned 5 consecutive budgets with no tax levy increases from the previous year
- The outrageous pension enhancements were isolated so that no new employees will receive them
- The County filed a major lawsuit against the actuarial firm that recommended the enhancements
- The size of the Milwaukee County Board was reduced from 25 to 19
- Eliminated waiting lists for long-term care for seniors through Family Care

“The greatest impact in the last 5 years of my administration is that we have addressed many of the devastating effects of spiraling benefit costs and over-taxation in Milwaukee County,” said Walker. “We have a lot to be proud of, but there is a lot of work still to be done.”
