TO: ALL MILWAUKEE COUNTY RETIREES

RE: WISCONSIN TAX WITHHOLDING

Each retiree should make his or her own determination regarding Wisconsin state income tax withholding by completing the certificate below. Wisconsin law does not require that state income tax be withheld from monthly annuity benefit payments, but you may specify an amount to be withheld each month or choose the applicable number of allowances and ERS will calculate the withholding amount for you based on the Wisconsin Tax Tables. If on the Federal Withholding Certificate you elected NO taxes to be withheld or you elected to have a specific dollar amount withheld, you will have NO taxes withheld for the State of Wisconsin, unless you elect to have amounts withheld on the certificate below.

If you became a member of the County Retirement System on or before December 31, 1963, your pension for Wisconsin State Tax purposes is reportable but NOT TAXABLE at the present time. If you are a Wisconsin resident and become a member of the Retirement System on or after January 1, 1964, your pension is TAXABLE INCOME for Wisconsin State Tax purposes. Regardless of your start date, if you are currently receiving an accidental disability pension, your pension is exempt from Wisconsin Income Tax.

Please complete the certificate below:

- A. You may adjust the amount of tax withheld by completing Box A, indicating whether you are married or single and indicating the appropriate number of allowances, or
B. You may elect to have NO tax withheld by completing Box B, or
C. You may choose an additional withholding amount by completing Box C.
D. You may elect a specific monthly withholding amount (not less than \$5.00) by completing Box D.

If you elect NOT to have any taxes withheld or if you do NOT have enough Wisconsin Income Taxes withheld from your pension, you may be responsible for the payment of estimated tax. You may incur penalties under the State of Wisconsin Estimated Tax rules if your withholding and estimated tax payments are not sufficient. Please note that any questions concerning this matter should be addressed to your personal tax advisor or the local office of the Internal Revenue Service or the Wisconsin Department of Revenue. ERS can only withhold state taxes for the State of Wisconsin.
