County Board's public affairs program airs Sunday on News/Talk 1130 WISN

Milwaukee, WI – The latest edition of *Inside the County Board* airs Sunday at 9:00 p.m. on News/Talk 1130 WISN radio in Milwaukee. The lineup for the April 4, 2010 program includes:

- County Auditor Jerome Heer gives listeners an inside look into how Milwaukee County government operates, collects taxes and provides services demanded by constituents. Includes discussion on government structure and long-term strategic decision-making.
- County Board Roundtable: Supervisors Michael Mayo, Sr., Joseph Rice, and Chris Larson tackle mass transit. Discussion includes debate over regional transit and funding.
- Supervisors Theodore Lipscomb and Johnny L. Thomas discuss their efforts to ensure that dollars invested in public works projects stay in Milwaukee County.

Inside the County Board airs the first Sunday of every month at 9:00 p.m. on News/Talk 1130 WISN and is hosted by the County Board's Public Information Manager, Harold Mester.
