Services for Seniors and Veterans

Our 11th District Veterans qualify for a wide range of services

The Milwaukee County Veterans Services Office is located at 5000 West National Avenue (Building 4) on the Zablocki VA Grounds. Built in the 1890's, it has served as the recreation center for veterans living on the grounds. The bowling alley in the lower level is still in use.

The main function of the Veterans Services Office is to inform veterans and their families of the many benefits available and provide assistance in the application process. Potential benefits available for veterans include personal loans, tuition reimbursement, compensation, aid and attendance pension, soldiers' homes and burial sites, home improvement and loan programs and inpatient or outpatient health care at the VA hospital.

The Veterans Services Office is also making a point to reach out to Vietnam Veterans, especially those that served in country and have never, or not recently utilized the services of the VA. Many of you may suffer from illnesses related to exposure to Agent Orange and the Veteran's Office is here to help.

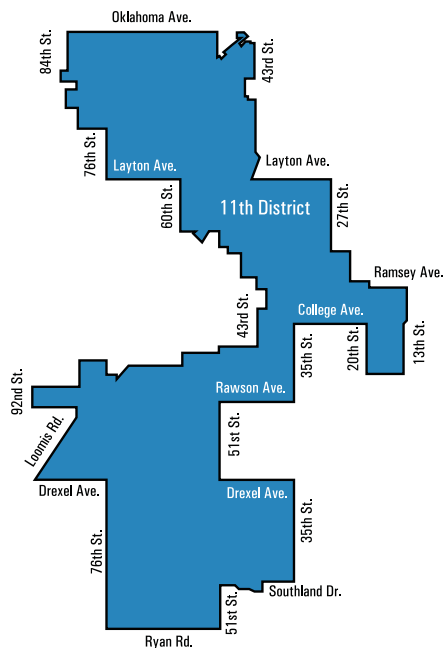
