Captain Kerri McKenzie, a 15-year veteran of the force, received the **2009 Sheriff's Superior Achievement Award** this past September at an awards ceremony at the Pfister Hotel.

The Sheriff needed command staff members to enforce fiscal discipline, display a can-do attitude and be committed to change. Captain Kerri McKenzie was one of those who stepped up to the task. In short, Captain McKenzie helped transition the 360 inmates housed at the County Correctional Facility-South and an additional 150+ out-of-custody inmates to roboCUFF voiceprint and expanded electronic monitoring, with no loss of operational security.

Please be a Good Neighbor. When you take your dog to the park, you **MUST** bring a bag or scooper to pick up after your dog and dispose of at your home.


