Dear Neighbors:

Thank you for allowing me to serve as your voice on the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors. It is an honor to represent the people of the 9th District.

While 2006 was a difficult year for Milwaukee County, the coming year will bring additional challenges and opportunities. We must deal with the impact of not just what has become called the "Pension Scandal", but also generous wage and benefit contracts and the compounding effect that all of this has on our ability to provide core services. I struggle to protect these services at a cost that you and your families can afford.

Recently, the County Board considered and passed a budget for 2007. I personally proposed three amendments to change structural problems with the pension and healthcare benefits; in addition, I supported other Supervisors' efforts and voted for amendments cutting excessive spending and reducing the property tax levy by more than \$6 million. Lacking these changes, I voted against the out-of-balance County Board Budget.

We can choose to either keep raising taxes or solve our underlying problems. I firmly believe this fiscal crisis demands action; I will be working with my colleagues to identify new and creative ways to reduce our healthcare and pension costs, set essential priorities, and eliminate excessive spending.

It will take us years to free ourselves from the bad decisions made by previous County officials. However, I know that by working together we can repair our Government. We can find new and innovative ways to build partnerships that not only maintain, but enhance, our parks and recreational opportunities, our public safety, our transportation systems, and other core services.
