Our trainers will include:

- **Elizabeth Hudson**, LCSW. Ms. Hudson works as the Trauma Services Coordinator at DHS in the Bureau of Prevention Treatment and Recovery. Her position was created in partnership with the UW-Madison's Department of Psychiatry. Elizabeth has worked in the field of trauma prevention and treatment for 20 years, both as a clinician and an administrator. She serves to champion awareness and Trauma Informed practices in human service systems throughout the State.
- **Beth Burazin**, trainer for Recovery, Person Centered Planning and a Trauma Champion. Beth is a peer specialist at United House, a social worker, and a former Health Facility Surveyor for the State.
- **Ann Umhoefer**, CEO of St. Aemelian's Lakeside - a local organization that has experienced the challenges and benefits "shifting perspective", to adopt trauma informed care. She will relate their ongoing process, and lessons learned, sharing 7 elements they have found essential for their organization, as they continue this journey.
