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2009 Budget

As your representative on the County Board and a member of the Finance and Audit Committee, I am keeping your interests in mind while reviewing and amending the County Executive's proposed 2009 Budget (www.county.milwaukee.gov/2009RecommendedOperatingBudget). The full Board will meet on **Monday, November 10**, to adopt the 2009 Budget and again on **Wednesday, November 19**, to consider vetoes from the Executive.

My constituents have requested to keep fees reasonable. In Budget Hearings, I voted to reject \$3 and \$6 increases on 9- and 18-hole golfing, instead opting for \$1.50 and \$3 respective increases. I also voted to keep our marina fees more competitive with other areas. The 16% proposed increase on slip and launch fees was unrealistic. The County Executive's Recommended Budget would have raised regular adult bus fares from \$2 to \$2.25 with similar increases to other fares. Our transit system fares are already among the highest in the United States, so I have favored smaller fare increases. I am pleased that transit routes will remain intact. My constituents depend on the bus to get to work and other necessary destinations.

Mental Health Complex

County Executive Scott Walker vetoed the Board's vote to reject the proposal to move the Mental Health Complex to the former St. Michael Hospital site. This proposal involved a long-term lease of this facility for use as a new mental health hospital with an expected sale of the land at the current complex. My vote supported keeping the St. Michael Hospital option available while a majority of the Board voted against the proposal. I will vote to sustain the County Executive's veto on this issue when the Board meets on **Thursday, November 6**.
