MEDICAL RESEARCH EXPANDS IN WAUWATOSA

The Milwaukee Regional Medical Center (MRMC) contributes substantially to the health of the Milwaukee area by providing advanced patient care, the State's highest-level emergency trauma center, cutting edge medical education and medical research.

Over \$450 million in new investment has been added to MRMC in the last five years including a joint Research Institute building and a state-of-the-art cancer pavilion. Further improvements are planned which will invest \$554 million in the next three years in the MRMC's campus. If you would like additional information about the MRMC, call 778-4570.

In 2006, the six-member MRMC was Wauwatosa's largest employer with 12% (1,900) of its employees being Wauwatosa residents. In the last four years, employment at MRMC has grown over 50% to more than 15,000 employees. Also, 2,081 full-time students and medical residents enroll each year. Over \$134 million of research funds have been granted to MRMC recently. Medical students, medical residents, employees and visitors to MRMC spend \$16 million annually in Wauwatosa.

I have worked cooperatively with MRMC and the City of Wauwatosa to address both the opportunities and challenges that come with this success.

Supervisor Schmitt's 2008 Budget Listening Session

On September 27, 2007, County Executive Walker is expected to unveil his 2008 Recommended Budget. The County Board's Finance and Audit Committee will review the proposed budget beginning in early October, including amendments offered by Supervisors. On Monday, October 29 at 7:00 p.m. in the Washington Park Senior Center, the County Board will hear public input on the proposed 2008 County Budget. The County Board will meet again on November 5 to vote on amendments and adopt a budget. The budget will be finalized on November 14 after the County Board meets to consider any vetoes made by the County Executive.
