City of Milwaukee Expands Distribution of FREE Flood Clean-up Kits

Additional shipments of kits have arrived and are available at city's Southside Health Center and Keenan Health Center to Assist Residents with Flood Clean-up

The City of Milwaukee is expanding the distribution of flood clean-up kits at two local area health centers. The free kits will be available at the Southside Health Center located at 1639 South 23rd Street and the Keenan Health Center located at 3200 N. 36th Street. The kits were awarded to the city by the American Red Cross in Southeastern Wisconsin for Milwaukee residents as they continue the cleaning and sterilization of their homes and businesses. The kits will be available for pick-up today Wednesday, June 18, 2008 on a first-come first-served basis while supplies last. The clean-up kits consist of a mop, broom, bucket, bleach, rubber gloves, garbage bags and sponges.
