MILWAUKEE HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO HOLD ADDITIONAL PUBLIC H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS

City receives shipment of 11,000 doses of both injectable and intranasal vaccine

MILWAUKEE (November 10, 2009) – The City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) today has received 11,000 additional doses of both the injectable and intranasal H1N1 vaccine, and will hold multiple vaccination clinics this week:

Vaccine will be administered to Milwaukee residents in the following target groups:

- Pregnant women
- Children ages 6 months-18 years
- Healthcare workers with direct patient contact
- Caregivers and household contacts of infants under 6 months of age

Residents are reminded that wait times may exceed one hour or more and to plan accordingly. A clinic consent form is posted on the MHD website at www.milwaukee.gov/health and is available in both English and Spanish. The MHD strongly encourages residents to download and complete the form and bring it with them to the clinic to assist in quicker registration processing. Vaccine will be provided as supplies remain available within the designated clinic hours. Persons outside the City of Milwaukee may call 211 for information on H1N1 vaccination clinic dates, times and locations within their community.
