MILWAUKEE HEALTH DEPARTMENT OPENS PUBLIC H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS TO GENERAL POPULATION

MILWAUKEE (November 19, 2009) – The City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) will administer H1N1 vaccine to all Milwaukee residents who attend its two vaccination clinics being held this week:

Residents are reminded that wait times may exceed one hour or more and to plan accordingly. A clinic consent form is posted on the MHD website at www.milwaukee.gov/health and is available in both English and Spanish. The MHD strongly encourages residents to download and complete the form and bring it with them to the clinic to assist in quicker registration processing. Vaccine will be provided as supplies remain available within the designated clinic hours.
