## **Board of Harbor Commissioners Appointments by Mayor Announced.**

The Port of Milwaukee is pleased to announce that **Daniel J. Steinger** was recently reappointed to serve on the board of commissioners of the Port of Milwaukee by Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett. Steinger, who was first appointed on September 1, 1977 has been reappointed by the mayor of Milwaukee after each consecutive 3-year term served, and serves as the President of the Harbor Commissioners.



“Steinger has initiated and overseen countless positive changes that are directly reflected in the port's continuous growth,” said Port Director Eric Reinelt.
