PARTICIPANT GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

The complaint may be expressed verbally, in writing, or by any alternative method through which the individual ordinarily communicates. You will not be discriminated against or threatened in any way for reporting a complaint. Whenever possible you should first attempt to resolve a complaint with the program staff involved.


