PARTICIPANT GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

It is the goal of Easter Seals Southeast Wisconsin, Inc. to ensure that all complaints are addressed and resolved in a timely manner. This complaint resolution process is designed to provide you with easy access to the correct contacts. A participant, guardian, ward, family member, caregiver or other interested party may report a complaint about services provided by Easter Seals Southeast Wisconsin, Inc. within 45 days of the occurrence. The complaint may be expressed verbally, in writing, or by any alternative method through which the individual ordinarily communicates. You will not be discriminated against or threatened in any way for reporting a complaint. Whenever possible you should first attempt to resolve a complaint with the program staff involved.


