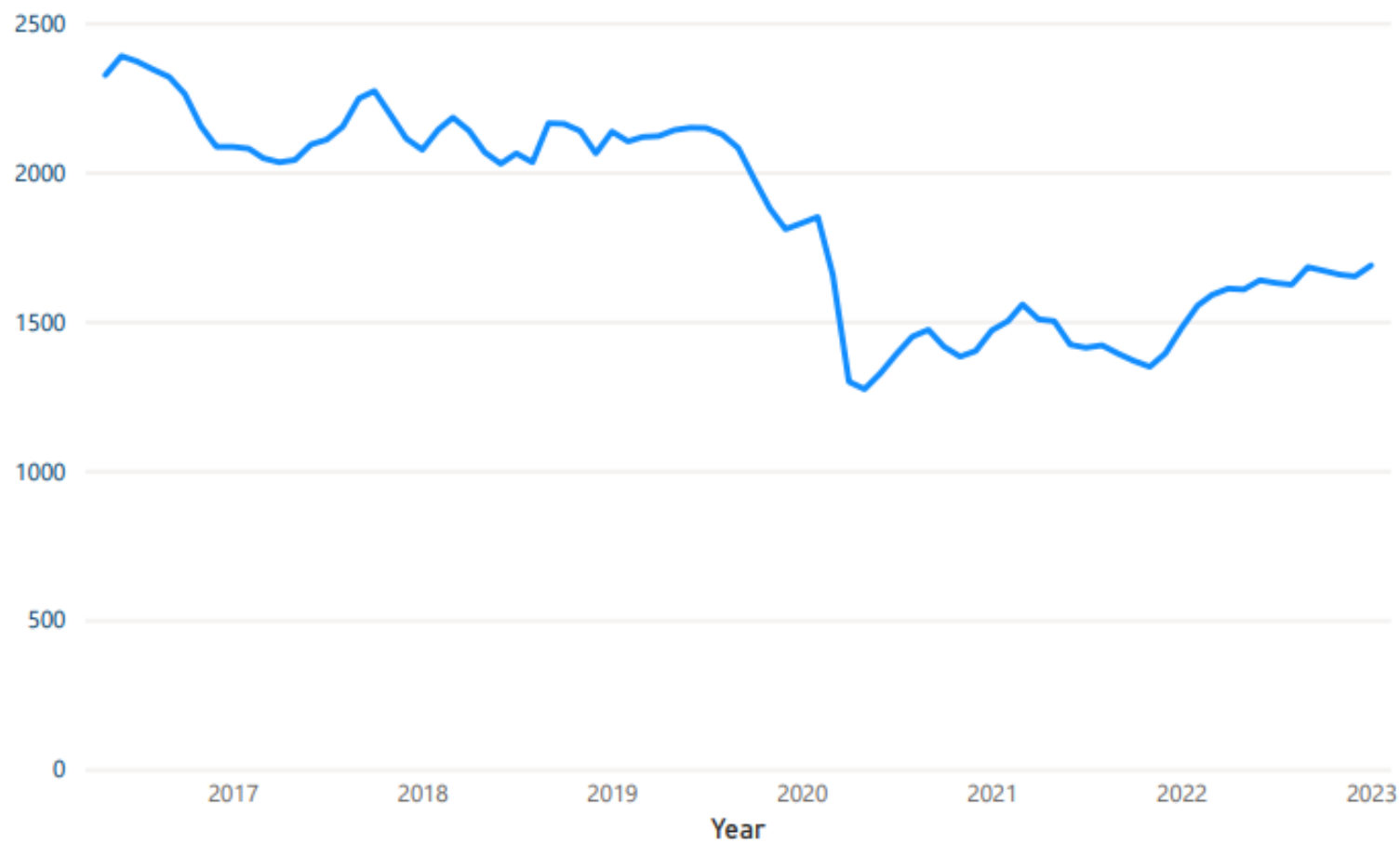

Safety and Justice Challenge Overview

- Initiative of the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation
- Goals
 - Implement reforms to safely reduce overreliance on jails
 - Address disparities in the criminal legal system
- Provides funding and technical assistance to implement site-specific strategies
- SJC Network has 74 sites; Milwaukee joined in 2016

Phase	Focus
Phase 1 2015	Engaged jurisdictions in strategy planning and development
Phase 2 2016 - 2018	Provided funding and technical assistance to implement strategies
Phase 3 2019 - 2020	Continued support, adding investments in community engagement
Phase 4 Sustainability 2021 - 2022	Deepened focus on racial equity and long-term sustainability
Phase 5 Capstone 2023 - 2025	Final funding to promote sustainability and uphold community engagement, racial equity, and data efforts
