- 1) **Call to Order** – meeting called to order by Chair White at 12:17pm
- 2) **Approval of September Executive Committee Minutes** – no changes requested.
- 3) **Introduction of Robin Broeske by David Budde** – DA Investigator, David Budde, introduced newest DA Investigator, Ms. Robin Broeske. Ms. Broeske is a 26-year veteran law enforcement officer who formerly worked for the WI DOJ Division of Criminal Investigation and will serve as the MacArthur Foundation funded countywide CART law enforcement partner.
- 4) **Introduction of Evans Gant** – County Executive Abele introduced Mr. Evans Gant as the new Director of Community Relations within the County Executive's Office.

 - a) **Data Committee**
 - i. **Responses to Auto Theft Analysis Questions** – Branden DuPont was unable to join today's meeting. Mandy will check in with Branden to verify whether information can be distributed prior to the next meeting for review. Mayor Barrett expressed concern over the pervasive auto-theft problem. There was extensive discussion regarding State vs. County juvenile probation, Lincoln Hills and local, secure supervision options. It was noted that DHHS is looking to secure a local location in the area of 34th and Hampton (Bishops Creek) for a staff secured facility; however, there has been push back from the community.
 - b) **Jail and Huber Utilization Committee**
 - i. **Jail and House of Correction Staffing Shortages** – it was briefly discussed that the jail and House of Correction are currently experiencing staffing shortages and this should remain on the radar of the Executive Committee for monitoring.



- ii. **Municipal Court Reforms** – Chief Judge White noted the State continues to pursue and will update the group as recommendations are formed.

- Sheldyn Himle noted the Milwaukee Municipal Court will be partnering with Journey House in 2018 to roll-out a warrant withdrawal event on the south side. In the interim, Judge Hill and Judge Mosely will be hosting an event at Greater New Birth Church on December 6th in the afternoon.
